Case in point, tenants of 300 Las Olas Place have experienced a 24% decrease in electricity costs as compared to before the program began. 300 Las Olas Place was Florida's first existing multi-tenant office building to achieve Gold-level LEED (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) certification for Existing Buildings from the U.S. Green Building Council.
