The Austrian Boarding Pass also offers culinary discounts. They can enjoy a Vienna Melange coffee free of charge at the Meinl am Graben café in Vienna and other cafes of Meinl in Belgrade, Istanbul, Kiev, Beijing and Moscow, and at the Café Landtmann in Tokyo.

Each boarding pass is valid for one person and for ten days after the flight date. Discounts are also available for passengers using boarding passes printed out as part of the Web Check-in service and for those using a mobile boarding pass on their mobile phone.
