## Republic of China Civil Aviation Authority Releases Formosa Airlines Final Accident Report

The Republic of China Civil Aviation Authority has released the final accident report for the March 18<sup>th</sup>, 1998 crash of Formosa Airlines Saab 340, Registration Number B-12255, which went down into the Formosa Strait shortly after takeoff.
