Sweco acquires City of Stockholm's Office of Research and Statistics

The City of Stockholm's Office of Research and Statistics, USK, currently has 34 employees. For more than 100 years the office has provided clients like the City of Stockholm with statistics, forecasts, research and studies on issues related to the region's development.

USK was incorporated in 2008. The acquisition of USK is conditional on a decision by the Stockholm City Council. The transfer of ownership is scheduled for 1 June 2011.
