The acquisition of MRL, which was previously a major customer to Kanthal in the U.S., is part of the development toward increased added value and forward integration, closer to the end-user.

"As a result of the acquisition, Kanthal enhances its competence in an industrial segment in the U.S. in which growth is expected to continue. Concurrently, the potential for increased sales in the electronics industry in Asia and Europe is also created," says Harry Furuberg, President of Kanthal.
