Allgon's latest cost reduction to save SEK 70 million

Allgon's latest cost saving measures, announced in November, will result in savings of SEK 70 million per year. The cost reduction will be in full effect from third quarter next year.

Allgon's result for the fourth quarter 2001 will debit Allgon's fourth quarter result by SEK 35 million.

Allgon is today negotiating with several customers on 3G equipment, including provisioning of filter panels, microwave links, TMA's and base station antennas. Allgon believes the demand for these products will increase during third quarter 2002.
