## SAS Cargo increases cargo activities to Italy

SAS cargo starts offering more capacity and more frequent departures to the northern part of Italy. This is the result of SAS Airline's decision to expand the number of destinations to this area by including Bologna and Venice.

## **New destinations**

As of November 3<sup>rd</sup> 2003 Bologna will be visited five times a week and as of summer 2004 Venice will be added the list of destinations with seven weekly departures. This means that as of summer 2004 SAS Cargo will be covering the most important cargo destinations in Northern Italy with more than 50 weekly departures from Scandinavia.

As of November 1<sup>st</sup> SAS Cargo has direct flights to Milano Malpensa, Milano Linate, Bologna and Rome, and from summer 2004 Venice will be added.
