Most Traded segment – first half of 2004

The purpose of the Most Traded segment is to highlight the companies on Stockholmsbörsen's A List with the most liquid shares. The segment is updated twice per year. Following the update conducted ahead of the first half of 2004, the segment will consist of a total of 28 companies. One company (AB Industrivärden) has been removed from the Most Traded segment and two new ones (Getinge AB and Trelleborg AB) have been added.

Qualifying rules for Most Traded segment of Stockholmsbörsen's A List

The requirements for being included in the Most Traded segment are that trading in the company's shares exceeded SEK 6 billion (corresponding to SEK 24 million per day) during the most recent measurement period and that the company had a market capitalization exceeding SEK 8 billion at the end of the measurement period. The measurement period consists of the immediately preceding 12 months and the checking dates are May 31 and November 30. New companies are added on the first day of trading per calendar half year. In special cases, a new company may be listed directly in the Most Traded segment, if it is regarded as highly probable that the above criteria will be met.
