NEW ORGANIZATION

To strengthen AGA's focus on profitability, a new organization will be introduced as of June 8. With this change it is expected that the on-going efficiency improvement program can be carried through earlier than planned.

The industrial gas operations, consisting of the Business Areas Manufacturing and Process Industry, will be split into five geographical regions headed by a Regional Manager with responsibility for earnings in his region. A Global Key Account Manager has been appointed to strengthen the co-operation with AGA's global customers.

Business Area Healthcare, AGA's medical gas operations, will continue as a global division.

Industrial gas operations

Healthcare Division, turnover SEK 2.0 billion. **Lars Källsäter**, 53, at present Business Area Manager Healthcare and employed by AGA since 1970.

The appointments at headquarters will be decided before the end of June, when the evaluation of adapting the central resources to the new organizational structure has been finalized.
