## Scania deliveries

Deliveries of Scania trucks during the period January through May 1999 increased by 5 percent compared to the same period of 1998.

1,431 (1,707) buses and 1,148 (1,159) industrial and marine engines were delivered during the period.

The Western European order intake remains on a high level. In Latin America the order intake is still affected by the uncertain market situation.
