

1. August in brief

Passenger traffic (RPK) showed an overall decrease of 2,9% in August 1999 vs. August 1998, while no. of passengers decreased by 2,0%. Overall capacity (ASK) increased by 2,2% and passenger load factor fell by 3.4 p.u. The continued change in passenger mix and the continued pressure on yields in Economy Class continue to put pressure on overall vields.


- Total passenger traffic (RPK) decreased by 2,9% in August 1999 vs. 1998.
- The number of passengers decreased by 2,0%.
- Business Class traffic was down 8,5% and Economy Class was down 1.1%.
- The passenger load factor decreased from 69,5% to 66,1%.

2. Passenger Traffic and Capacity per route area – August 1999

Intercontinental traffic decreased by 2,7% in August. With a capacity increase of 2,4%, the passenger load factor fell from 86,0% to 81,7%. Traffic to/from Asia showed increased cabin factor, while the opposite was noted for North America.

European traffic continued to develop weakly. Development in Business Class has improved slightly to/ from London and Brussels, but developed slightly weaker on Paris and Amsterdam.

Intrascandinavian traffic was weak on most areas, traffic between Sweden and Norway in particular.

Danish domestic traffic developed with increased cabin factor on Danish mainland and decreased cabin factor on traffic to/ from Greenland. For the first time in several months, traffic to/ from Aarhus developed with growth both in Business Class and Tourist Class.

Norwegian domestic total market grew by approximately 7% and measured in number of passengers, SAS traffic was up 3,6%. For the fifth consecutive month SAS experienced a stronger growth than its main competitor.

Swedish domestic was the only route area with traffic growth and increased cabin factor in August. Overall increase in traffic was 5.0% and as a result overall cabin-factor increased by 0,9 p.u. The growth was partly stimulated by Economy Class summer campaigns.
