Deliveries of Scania trucks during the period January through August 1999 were virtually unchanged.

2,409 (2,680) buses and 1,891 (1,722) industrial and marine engines were delivered during the period.

The Western European order intake remains on a high level. In Latin America the order intake is still affected by the uncertain market situation.

With 23,500 employees and production facilities in Europe and Latin America, Scania is one of the most profitable companies in its sector.
