Skanska to rebuild Garnisonen property in Linköping for SEK 165 million

Skanska has been commissioned by the real estate company Vasallen AB to rebuild and extend the Garnisonen property in Linköping. The estimated value of the project is SEK 340 million. Skanska's order, which relates to construction activities, is worth SEK 165 million. The project comprises approximately 40,000 m², including 17,000 m² of new production.

Vasallen AB will lease the new and rebuilt premises to the police authorities, the prosecuting authorities and the National Swedish Criminal Police Registry and Forensic Laboratories (SKL).
