Continued improved load factors in September

- SAS Group load factor for September was 71,2% up 5,9 p.u. vs 2004.
- Total passenger traffic (RPK) increased by 9,7% in September 2005 vs 2004.
- The SAS Group transported 3,4 million passengers in September 2005, an increase of 13,0%.
- Scandinavian Airlines Businesses' load factor in September was up 7,9 p.u. to a record 74,0%

Group market trends and yield development Group total traffic volumes (RPK) developed well in September with an increase of 9,7%. Capacity (ASK) increased by 0,6% resulting in improved load factor of 5,9 p.u. to 71,2%.

As from September 1st Scandinavian Airlines and Blue 1 has introduced new Business Models with one-way fares and simplified rules on European and Intrascandinavian routes.

Due to the relatively short timeframe this model has been active it is too early to make conclusions on the effects, but the expected yield drop to be offset by improved passenger load factor seems on track so far. Yields for August were down 1,2% compared with 2004. Yields for Scandinavian Airlines for September are preliminary and expected to be less than last year at an estimated level of -5%-10%, offset by improved load. Final figures will be provided in the October traffic report.

Traffic and load factor trends continued to improve in September compared with last year.

Some signs of reduced capacity in the marketplace have emerged, but overall and due to the situation with continued overcapacity and the competitive situation with price pressure in many markets the overall outlook remains cautious.

Intercontinental traffic was up by 0,5% in September. Passenger load factor improved by 6,1 p.u. to 87,3%. SAS Group European traffic increased by 17,6% and passenger load factor increased by 7,2 p.u.. The introduction of Scandinavian Airlines new business model on European routes has been well received and load factor increased by 11,6 p.u. to 71,8%. Traffic on Swedish domestic routes continued to develop well and load factor increased by 11,6 p.u. to 65,0%. Blue 1 in Finland continued with strong growth with an increase in traffic of 23,6%. Blue 1's passenger load factor improved by 10,3 p.u. to 61,1%. Spanair's traffic was up 20,3% and load factor was up 1,5 p.u. to 66,7%.

Scandinavian Airlines Businesses

- Scandinavian Airlines passenger load factor increased by 7,9 p.u. to a record 74,0% for September.
- European loads increased by 11,6 p.u. to 71,8%.

Total intercontinental traffic was up 0,5% vs last year and capacity was down 6,5% as one aircraft was out of traffic most of September. Overall load factor on the intercontinental routes was up 6,1 p.u. to 87,3%. Traffic on the European routes was up by 3,1% and load factor was up 11,6 p.u. as a result of the introduction of the new European business model. Intrascandinavian traffic was on the same level as in September 2004 although capacity was decreased by 7,6%, resulting in an improved load factor of 4,9 p.u. to 64,7%.

Scandinavian Airlines Businesses continued...

Scandinavian Airlines Danmark's traffic decreased slightly by 0,8% as a result of capacity adjustments, but passenger load factor increased by a strong 10,9 p.u.. On European routes traffic increased by 4,3% and cabin factor improved by 13,0 p.u..

SAS Braathens traffic increased by 8,9%. European routes developed well and traffic increased by 17,2%. Total load factor was up 3,7 p.u. to 65,4%.

Spanair traffic development

Following the expansion plans and compared to September last year capacity (ASK) increased by 17,5%. Passengers carried increased by 25,2% and traffic (RPK) with 20,3%. The passenger load factor increased by 1,5 p.u. to 66,7%.

The increase is mainly within the domestic network on the mainland. In the previous months Spanair launched two new destinations and five new routes and as from September a new route from Barcelona to Vigo with three daily frequencies has been added to the network. Compared to last year domestic capacity increased by 21,4%. Traffic followed closely the capacity growth, the passengers increased by 26,5% and traffic by 21,0 resulting in a lower passenger load factor of -0,2 p.u. to 67,7%.

In Europe capacity increased with 4,3%. Passengers grew by 13,1% and traffic by 17,5% resulting in an increase of 7,0 p.u. in the load factor.

Widerøe's traffic development

The total number of passengers increased by 0.4% in September compared with last year. Overall load factor was slightly down to 55.8%, mainly because of capacity increases that have not been met fully by demand on the Domestic and Intrascandinavian sectors. However, on the European sector the load factor showed a strong 10.0 p.u. increase, to 60.9%.

Blue 1's traffic development

The positive traffic development continued in September. The traffic (RPK) increased by 24% and capacity (ASK) increased by 3% compared with last year. Traffic on domestic routes increased by 76% and the capacity 46% compared to September 2004. Number of passengers increased by 25% compared to last year. On the domestic routes the increase was 79% and on the International routes 15%. The total cabin factor was in September 61.1%, up 10,3 p.u. compared with last year. The cabin factor was up on the domestic routes +11.1 p.u and on the International routes; +9.8 p.u.. Accumulated January - September Blue1 has carried 1,1 million passengers, 29% more than last year.

airBaltic traffic development

airBaltic total number of passengers in September 2005 increased by 65.4% compared to last year, RPK increased by 82.3% and ASK by 56.8%. Passenger load factor increased by 8.1p.u to 58.3%.

In comparison to September 2004, airBaltic operates to 6 more destinations from Riga, but the same number of destinations from Vilnius.

Riga base number of passengers increased by 41.9%, ASK by 50.1% and RPK by 55.2%. Passenger load factor increased by 1.8 p.u to 54.7%.

Vilnius base number of passengers increased by 175.4% compared to last year, ASK by 77.8% and RPK by 189.1%, load factor was 67.8% - increase by 26.1 p.u.

Scandinavian Airlines Sverige's number of passengers

increased by strong 17,1%. Load factors increased on European routes with 12,0 p.u. and on Swedish domestic routes with 11,6 p.u..

Punctuality & regularity (September)

Within 15 minutes 86,6% of flights departed on time and within 2 minutes 61,4% of flights departed on time. The regularity was 98,5%.

Internet Sales (August)

The proportion of Internet sales was 28,3% in August 2005.
