This will give us the opportunity to invest in other lines of business that we see as more interesting for us in the future, says President of the Interpegro Group Venjamin Gurevich.

The Latvian food retail market is characterised by increased competition after RIMI's establishment in the market in 1996/97, where traditionally open markets have played an important role. During the last years, however, we have seen a development towards larger self-service supermarkets.

The agreement between ICA AB and the Interpegro Group has been approved by the Board of both companies and by relevant authorities in Latvia.
