## SZCZECIN TO BE NEW SAS DESTINATION

SAS continues its strategic expansion into Eastern Europe by adding a new destination on the SAS route network: Szczecin in Poland. SAS will be the first to start a direct international route to the Polish port city, where numerous Scandinavian companies are established. Szczecin is the fourth destination for SAS in Poland following Warsaw, Gdansk and Poznan. The nonstop route Copenhagen- Szczecin starts up on April 28 and will be flown five days per week with the 46-seat Fokker 50 aircraft.

Szczecin, with a population of 500,000, is a one-hour flight from Copenhagen. SAS's morning departure from Copenhagen will provide excellent connections from many European cities. The return flight from Szczecin arrives in Copenhagen early afternoon, giving good opportunity to continue on to other European destinations.

SAS is already established in Szczecin with a 369-room Radisson SAS hotel, located in the heart of the business district.
