DAHL CONTINUES ITS EXPANSION IN THE DANISH INDUSTRIAL MARKET

Dahl International AB (publ) is to acquire Maskinkompagniet Odense A/S, a wholesaler focusing on the industrial market.

The company, which is established in Odense and Kolding, has annual turnover of more than MDKK 40 and 25 employees. Geographically, Maskinkompagniet will form a good complement to the previous acquisitions in the tool segment, SCS Industriværktøj (Sept. 1997) and OP Værktøj (Jan. 1998), through its establishments on Funen and southern Jutland. The combined sales for 1998 are expected to be in excess of MDKK 200.

Maskinkompagniet will be a wholly owned subsidiary of Brødrene Dahl in Denmark, making Dahl more complete in the industrial market and boosting sales of the existing took range.

"In the short time we have secured a solid position in tool sales and strengthened our profile among industrial customers", comments Dahl's President P-O Söderberg.
