# **ÅF** Group wins Akzo Nobel assignment

The ÅF Group has prevailed over fierce competition to secure the assignment to plan a new production line for Akzo Nobel's operations in Örnsköldsvik, in the north-east of Sweden. The project will extend to 12,000 consulting hours and will require the skills and expertise of around 15 ÅF Group consultants within the fields of process technology, IT, and electrical, mechanical and HVAC engineering.
