PartnerTech develops and manufactures electronics products on contract basis for leading growth companies, primarily within the fields of telecommunications, information technology, and medical technology. The company, which has a total of approximately 1,000 employees in Sweden and abroad, is listed on the Stockholm Stock Exchange O-list.
