## Saab Aviocomp and Embraer sign Service Center Agreement

Saab Aviocomp AB has signed an agreement with Embraer Aviation International under which it becomes an authorized service center for the maintenance of components installed on aircraft manufactured by Embraer, primarily ERJ135/140/145 and EMB120 Brasilia.

"We are pleased that Embraer has selected Saab Aviocomp to provide aircraft component maintenance services for themselves and their customers' aircraft," says Jan-Ingvar Johansson, President of Saab Aviocomp AB.
