New hotel for Scandic in Forssa

Scandic and Hämeen Valtatieravintolat Oy have signed a franchise agreement regarding the Pumpulienkeli hotel in Forssa. With this agreement, the privately owned Pumpulienkeli hotel will join the Scandic chain on 1st of June 2010 and be renamed Scandic Forssa.
