Everton's Tim Cahill to Meet Fans and Sign Copies of His New DVD at HMV Liverpool ONE on Thursday

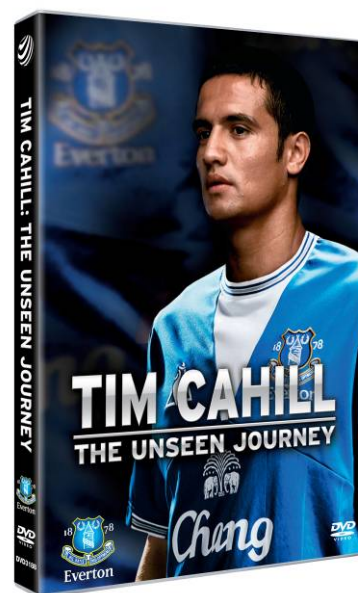
