Truck deliveries in August 2010

Total deliveries from the Volvo Group's truck operations in August amounted to 11,482 vehicles. This was an increase of 62% compared with the year-earlier period.

Volvo Trucks

Globally, deliveries in August were 100% higher than in the corresponding month last year.

In Europe, demand continues to recover gradually. Deliveries were up 90% compared to the very low level in August 2009.

Demand in the South American and Asian markets remains strong and deliveries in August amounted to 1,500 and 593 trucks, an increase with 78% and 94% respectively, compared to August 2009.

In North America deliveries in August totalled 1,210 vehicles, up 151% compared with the year-earlier period. The result reflects an increased demand in the highway truck segment of the Class 8 market, and the very positive reaction of customers to Volvo's SCR-equipped EPA2010 trucks.

In response to increasing demand, production is being gradually ramped up in both the European and North American plants.

Mack

Mack's deliveries in August totaled 986 vehicles, up 31% compared with the year-earlier period.

While the market for construction trucks remains depressed, customer activities has increased in the highway and refuse segments. In response to an improvement in these two segments for the new EPA10 trucks, a gradual ramp up of production at the Macungie plant in North America is being implemented during October.

Renault Trucks

Deliveries from Renault Trucks in August increased by 56% compared with the year-earlier period.

The increase is coming from higher deliveries of medium- and heavy-duty trucks in Western Europe.

UD Trucks

Deliveries from UD Trucks in August totaled 2,342 units, which was an increase of 51% compared with the year-earlier period.

In Asia, the number of deliveries was 1,885 units, increased by 64% whereof Japan increased the number of deliveries to 1,254 units, up 21%. Demand in Japan is currently sluggish post the governmental incentive programs for truck purchases expired during the summer.

However, in South East Asia demand continues to recover and the number of deliveries was 535 units, an increase by 239%.
