It will serve as an important reference for all of North America as well as being a first step into the highly quality-oriented Canadian healthcare market, in which women are very aware of their rights and well-being," says Jesper Söderqvist, President of Sectra's mammography operations.

Patient dose is high on the agenda in the radiology community. With its superior image quality, Sectra MicroDose Mammography generates by far the lowest dose of radiation of all of the systems offered in the market. Already today, Sectra MicroDose contributes to reducing radiation doses in 18 European countries, as well as in Australia, New Zealand and Japan. The Sectra MicroDose solution is used in all major mammography screening programs in Europe.
