Stockholm, Sweden – October 17, 2001 – AU-System has signed a general agreement with the Scania Association of Local Authorities (*Kommunförbundet Skåne*) regarding consulting services for local government IT infrastructure programmes. The agreement, which is the result of coordinated purchasing by the Scania Association on behalf of 25 local authorities in Scania, southern Sweden, runs to the end of 2003. The foundation for this model is the Swedish government's IT bill, which has been drawn up by the ministry of industry, employment and communications (*Näringsdepartementet*) with the ambition to achieve a fair distribution of broadband access throughout the whole of Sweden.

"Broadband IT infrastructure makes local authorities attractive to both companies and people. Local authorities also lie behind much of the continued development and use of IT services in Sweden.
