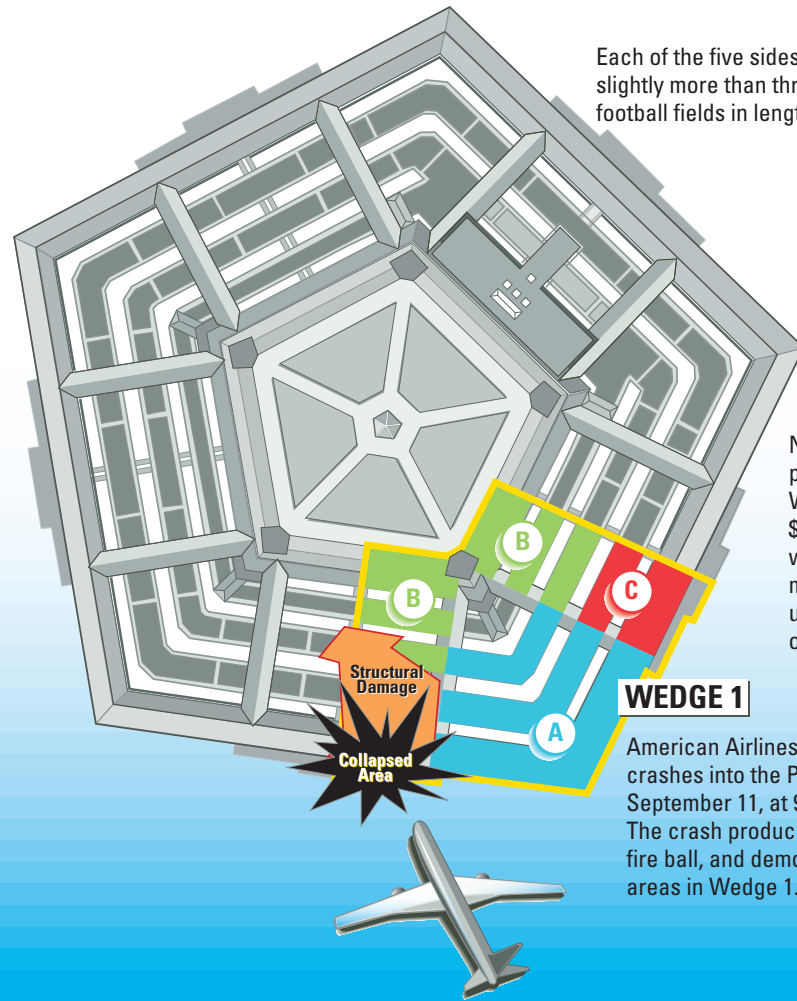


Water Damage Drying to Save Pentagon More Than \$40 Million In Recovery Costs.



Each of the five sides is slightly more than three football fields in length.

Normally, about 5000 people would work in Wedge 1. However, a \$258 million renovation was underway, leaving much of the Wedge unoccupied at the time of the attack.

WEDGE 1

American Airlines Flight 77 crashes into the Pentagon, September 11, at 9:30 A.M. The crash produces a 60 foot fire ball, and demolishes areas in Wedge 1.

A Nearest the blast and fire. Very heavy water damage resulted in substantial mold growth. Munters saved newly installed electrical, mechanical and structural components.

B Heavy water damage and some mold growth. Munters saves 60% of the sheetrock and all structural and mechanical materials. Stops further mold growth by drying.

C Some water damage and minor mold growth. Munters restores entire area in less than a week. Drying protects area ambient humidity problems.
