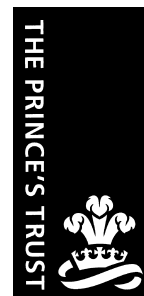

AT PARTY IN THE PARK**

England and Liverpool striker Emile Heskey received a Royal welcome at Capital 95.8 FM's Party in the Park for The Prince's Trust on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> July.
