Telia signs agreement for co-locating 3G operator masts

Telia Mobile AB signed a framework agreement today with 3G-operator Hi3G, covering the co-location of masts.

According to the terms of the agreement, Telia Mobile AB will lease space on its existing masts in Sweden, on market terms, for co-locating and installing the UMTS antennas of the other company, where there is available space. Telia Mobile is equally granted co-location in Hi3G:s masts.

"It's pleasing that we operators in the industry have signed an agreement based on sound business-like principles that all involved parties are satisfied with," commented Kenneth Karlberg, President of Telia Mobile AB.

Telia Mobile has previously reached framework agreements with Orange and Tele2 about colocating their UMTS antennas on Telia Mobile's masts.
