Scandinavian Airlines resumes direct traffic Stockholm – Bangkok

Effective December 12 this year, Scandinavian Airlines is resuming direct flights between Stockholm and Bangkok.

The flights will be scheduled three times weekly, with departures from Stockholm on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays at 9:30 p.m. Travelers arrive in Bangkok on the following day at 2:00 p.m. local time. This provides the possibility for SAS passengers to make a connection with Scandinavian Airlines to Singapore that departs Bangkok at 4:10 p.m.
