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CSC and V&S Sign \$25 Million IT Outsourcing Agreement

The five-year agreement is valued at approximately \$25 million.

Under the agreement, which becomes effective Oct. 1, 2003, CSC will assume responsibility for V&S Group's IT infrastructure in Sweden and Denmark, including data center and help desk operations, networks and desktop computers. CSC will also consolidate V&S Group's mid-range servers to improve efficiency and support the company's future growth.
