## **Micro Systemation signs licensing agreement with AboCom Systems Inc.**

***Micro Systemation AB is beginning a collaboration with AboCom Systems, Taiwan's biggest, and one of the world's most important, OEM suppliers of PC card modems.***

AboCom Systems will be integrating SoftGSM in its multi-functional cards, with several functions in one and the same PC card. AboCom is active nowadays as an OEM supplier in Asia, Europe and America. The company is OEM supplier to the Intel Corporation, Toshiba and D-Link, among others.

The agreement is expected in the long run to include the sale of 1,000 licenses per month.
