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### “Top ten” in mobile phone sales at Telia’s retail stores in July

As in June, the Nokia 3310 with Telia Refill prepaid card was the best-selling mobile phone for the month of July in Telia’s retail stores in Sweden. Sony Ericsson’s T230 was the second best-selling handset. The new Sony Ericsson K700i was a new entrant in the top ten list and came in third place. Six out of ten mobile phones on the best seller list for July come from Sony Ericsson.

Telia, with 74 stores, is the largest retail chain in Sweden for telecom products and one of Sweden’s largest resellers of mobile phones.

TeliaSonera is listed on the Stockholm Exchange, the Helsinki Exchanges and the Nasdaq Stock Market in the USA. Pro forma net sales January-December 2003 amounted to SEK 81.7 billion (EUR 9.01 billion). The number of employees was 26,694.
