Success for Sony Ericsson V800 3G mobile phone straight to No. 1 at Vodafone Sweden's stores

There can be no doubt about the popularity of Sony Ericsson's new 3G mobile phone, the Sony Ericsson V800, which went straight to the top of November's sales list in Vodafone Sweden's stores.

"This is the first 3G handset to top our list and it does so with a vengeance. Despite only being available in stores since 10 November, it has outsold every other model this month.
