Sectra invests in women's health Prime Minister Göran Persson to inaugurate production in Kista

On Thursday, April 14, at 4:00 PM (CET), Prime Minister Göran Persson will inaugurate production of mammography systems in Kista, Stockholm.

The research project that begun in the 90s at the Royal Institute of Technology have developed into an industry that employs 50 people. An additional 25 already work in subcontracting for Sectra's facility in Kista.

In the new facility, there is space both for production and development of digital mammography systems. Sectra's investments are based on the radiology detector developed by Associate Professor Mats Danielsson and his colleagues at the Royal Institute of Technology. The research group is now working at Sectra and the detector is revolutionizing mammography with the market's lowest radiation dose.

With its low radiation dose, Swedish Sectra is now challenging the major medical technology companies in the international market.
