LOT Polish Airlines har i dag indgået en Skandinavisk aftale med SAS Ground Services. Aftalen vedrører ground handling i lufthavnene Copenhagen Airport i Danmark, Gardermoen i Norge og Arlanda i Sverige.

Aftalen indebærer at SAS Ground Services nytegner en ground handling kontrakt i Copenhagen Airport, som træder i kraft den 15 juni 2005. For Arlanda og Gardermoen er aftalen en fornyelse af nuværende kontrakt og er gældende fra og med d. 1 januar 2005. Totalt set drejer det sig om ca. 50 afgangene om ugen.
