The companies which comprise SEC include: Tele2 Europe, providing national and international long distance telephony services in Austria, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, the Netherlands and Switzerland; Transcom Europe providing customer care services and call centers; Tango, the GSM 900/DCS 1800 cellular operator in Luxembourg, providing a broad range of mobile telecommunication services; 3C Communications, operating public pay telephones and public Internet services and Transac (formerly Transcom International) providing billing and transaction processing services. SEC has recently launched a number of new operations including Everyday.com, C³ and IntelliNet. SEC A and B shares are listed on: the Luxembourg Stock Exchange; the Nasdaq Stock Market as ADS under the symbols SECAY and SECBY; the Frankfurt Stock Exchange under the symbols SEN1 and SEN2 and the Stockholm Stock Exchange O-List under the symbols SECA and SECB.
