The company has established operations in the regions of Volgograd, Voronezh and Tambov. The company is planning to harvest approximately 50 000 hectares in 2008.

Alpcot Agro expects to control more than 200 000 hectares by the end of 2008.

Alpcot Agro is a Swedish limited liability company and was incorporated in 2006. The company objective is to generate an attractive total return on invested capital by acquiring and farming agricultural land in Russia and potentially in other CIS member states.

The company has as of today gained control of 108 700 hectares, of witch 51 800 are in ownership, and plans to continue to acquire farmland as long as land prices are attractive. The company expects to control more than 200,000 hectares and harvest more than 50,000 hectares in 2008. Alpcot Agro plans to list its shares on a Swedish stock market before the end of 2008.
