# Truck deliveries August 2008

**Total deliveries of trucks from the Volvo Group's five truck companies in August amounted to 14,849, which is an increase of 4%, compared with the year-earlier period.**

## Mack

Deliveries in August totaled 1,266 vehicles, down 12% compared with the year-earlier period. While the overall North American heavy-duty truck market was weak during both periods, the 08 figures reflect, in particular, a more pronounced softness in housing construction. Ongoing sluggishness in the U.S. economy as a whole, including the impact of tighter credit, as well as high fuel prices also continue to weigh on the market.

## Renault Trucks

Deliveries in August totaled 2,933 trucks, down 18% compared with the previous year. The decrease was primarily driven by lower deliveries in Southern Europe. The slowdown in many European economies, in combination with high fuel prices, continues to affect truck demand adversely.

## Volvo Trucks

Volvo Trucks' deliveries during August amounted to 5,891 vehicles, up 6% compared with the year-earlier period. The increase in August is mainly driven by higher volumes in Asia and Eastern Europe, though partly offset by a negative impact from production change-over to a new product range. The economic uncertainty in Europe has led to a slowdown in truck demand in several European markets. In North America the demand for trucks remains at a low level. The demand remains strong in Asia including Middle East, South America and Africa.

## Nissan Diesel

Deliveries from Nissan Diesel totaled 3,867 trucks in August, up 4% from the corresponding period a year ago. In Asia, the number of deliveries was 2,904 units, increased by 11%. The increase was primarily driven by an increase of 111% to Middle East and an increase of 9% to South East Asia.

In Japan, the number of trucks delivered was 1,561 units, a decrease of 1%.
