

Monthly Traffic & Capacity Data - September 2000

1. September in brief

Passenger traffic (RPK) was up 10,1% in September. Overall capacity (ASK) was up 0,7% and passenger load factor increased by 6,1 p.u.

Trading conditions continued to improve in September with strong traffic growth and record improvements on capacity utilization.

However, it is important to note that September 1999 was exceptionally weak.

3rd Quarter summary

In summary, 3rd Quarter 2000 showed significant traffic growth and positive developments in passenger mix. The traffic increase in 3rd Quarter 2000 as a whole was 8,6%. It must be noted that traffic in 3rd Quarter 1999 fell by 3%, resulting in 5,4% increase vs. 1998. Also, the positive development on revenues is expected to be largely offset by the increases in prices of Jet Fuel.

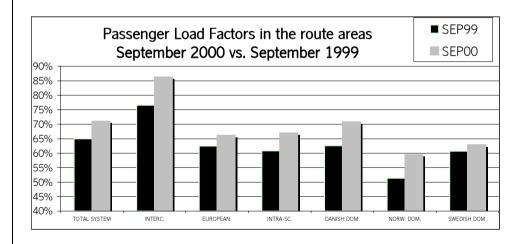
- Total passenger traffic (RPK) increased by 10,1% in September 2000 vs. 1999.
- The number of passengers increased by 6,4%.
- Total Business Class traffic was up 9,5% and Economy Class was up 10.4%.
- The passenger load factor increased from 65,0% to 71,0%.

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2. Passenger Traffic and Capacity per route area – September 2000

The capacity utilization Intercontinental routes increased by 9.7 p.u. to 86.3% in September. Both the Asian routes and the routes to North America developed well. In particular the traffic to / from Beijing developed well.

European showed increased passenger load factor on most routes. In particular routes to Germany, Poland and Finland developed well. Even routes to/ from the CIS are starting to recover.

Intrascandinavian routes showed strong traffic growth resulting in lack of capacity during peak hours. This is particularly a problem for traffic to/ from Copenhagen both from Oslo and Stockholm.

Danish domestic increased by 0,7% in September. The Greenland route showed positive development as tourism is picking up on this continent. A stabilization of traffic development was noted on Danish mainland.

Total **Norwegian domestic** market was weak also in September. Accumulated for 2000 the total market is down approximately 2%. Increased prices, high levels of government charges are damping the overall demand. SAS traffic was up 2,7% and passenger load factor improved to 59.5 % as capacity adjustments continued on Norwegian domestic. SAS continues to gain market shares on Norwegian domestic.

Swedish domestic continued to develop well in September. SAS traffic was up 12.8% and capacity was up 8.8%, affected by introduction of the new generation Boeing 737. Number of trips remained flat. Passenger load factors showed an improvement and ended at 62,9%.
