Systemair received an order to Delhi airport

The ventilation company Systemair received a large order for Terminal 3 that is under construction at Delhi Indira Gandhi International airport. The order includes different types of fans to a value of approx. 470,000 EUR.

The fans are delivered from Systemair's production plants in Sweden, Germany, Slovenia and Singapore. Some products will be assembled at Systemair India's new premises in Alwar, that was inaugurated in February this year.

– This is a breakthrough for us on the Indian market, says Svein Nilsen, vice president sales & marketing in Systemair. – Our broad product range has made it possible for us to get the project. The order value will probably increase as we have also received additional inquiries for fans.

With the construction of Terminal 3, Delhi's airport will be one of the largest in Asia. The terminal will have 75 gate bridges and 160 check-in counters. Inauguration is estimated to take place in March 2010.

Systemair in brief

Systemair is a leading ventilation company with operations in 38 countries in Europe, North America, the Middle East, Asia, Africa and Australia. In the 2007/08 financial year, the Company had sales of approximately SEK 3.1 billion and currently employs about 1,950 people. Since it was founded in 1974, the Company has increased sales every year and at the same time reported an operating profit. During the past three years, the Company's growth rate has averaged roughly 18 percent. The Group comprises about 50 companies.

Systemair has well-established operations in growth markets. The Group's products are marketed under the Systemair, Frico, VEAB and Fantech brands. Systemair shares have been quoted on the Mid Cap List of the OMX Nordic Exchange in Stockholm since October 2007.
