Over the years since 1994, NCC Denmark has developed Langelinie, at Copenhagen Harbor, into an exciting city district. The development consists of a total of 61,000 m² of offices, retail premises and residences with a total project value of SEK 1.7 billion, of which NCC Denmark has completed work totaling SEK 1.25 billion on a turnkey contract basis.

The sale will be included in NCC Real Estate's fourth-quarter earnings for real estate development.
