The Tiger system also enables encrypted data transmission and faxes, which are used frequently between the ministries.

Sectra's close cooperation with customers and national security agencies in many countries has resulted in the company's solutions for secure communications now being deployed in 17 European countries, in the EU and NATO. Users are decision-makers and officials in governments, defense authorities and functions critical to society, such as municipalities, county councils, police, customs, rescue services and the coast guard. A shared demand from all of these is the ability to use security-approved products and to communicate securely, while placing stringent demands on flexibility and mobility.
