Hot products on Innovative Sweden international tour

The Swedish institute has selected the 20 hottest Swedish inventions for an international exhibition tour called *Innovative Sweden*, presenting cutting edge innovations within the fields of Information and Communication Technology (ICT), Life Science, Clean Technology and Gaming. The Swedish robotics initiative Robotdalen cooperates with two of the selected companies: Penny and Giraff Technologies. The exhibition kicks off at Stanford University in California, USA, on November 2-9, 2011, and will be on tour around the world until December 2013.

The two companies that Robotdalen cooperate with are:

- Penny AB that develops the Penny Interactive Glasses System for interaction and communication with computers, leaving your hands free for other tasks. In cooperation with Robotdalen the system is tested in the project Robot Colleague. The project aims at making programming of industrial robots easier by using speech, gestures and vision. The interactive glasses are now being tested in the project.
- Giraff Technologies AB that has developed the Giraff, a remote-controlled mobile robot with a camera and
 monitor providing remote assistance and security to the elderly in their own homes. Giraff is a 1.5-metre high
 motorised, two-way video call robot that functions similarly to Skype. It's on wheels and can be controlled
 remotely via an ordinary PC. Disabled and elderly people can use it to communicate both with home
 assistance services and family and friends.
- We congratulate Penny and Giraff Technologies on being selected for the international innovation tour and look forward to continued cooperation with them, says Erik Lundqvist, General Manager of Robotdalen. Robotdalen is an enabler of commercial success of new ideas and research within robotics and automation, and us cooperating with 2 out of the 20 companies that have been selected for the tour is a nice confirmation for us on our work as well.
