"We do see the demand for our services grow further also in China, which is the reason why we decided to expand our footprint with an additional factory in the Greater Shanghai region. The cooperation with the members of Changshu municipal government and CSDZ has been very supportive, and we found a right level of entrepreneurial spirit, proactive attitude and high professionalism. Therefore, our choice for the new location to be in CSDZ was logical. When you add the fact, that Changshu is an extremely dynamic city; with excellent educational environment and remarkably strong infrastructure, we are confident to have found the right place for our investment", states Mr. Dirk Zimanky, President and CEO Enics AG.

The size of the new Enics site is 10.000 m2, and there is the possibility to double the floor space. The Changshu site will employee several hundred of people and it is expected to start operations within the second quarter of 2012.
